What are Admiral Nurses?

Admiral Nurses provide the specialist dementia support that families need.

When things get challenging or difficult, our Nurses work alongside people with dementia, their families and carers: giving the one-to-one support, expert guidance and practical solutions people need, and that can be hard to find elsewhere.

Admiral Nurses receive continual training, development and support from Dementia UK. Families that have their support have a nurse with expert knowledge and a caring nature by their side - helping them to live more positively with dementia in the present, and to face the challenges of tomorrow with more confidence and less fear.

The Admiral Nursing Service within our trust also provide training sessions for staff within the trust.
