

HOW TO CROCHET A TWIDDLE MUFF

Muff Body

1. Row 1 With 2 strands of double knitting wool, (or you can also use 1 strand of chunky wool) chain 45
2. Slip stitch into first chain to make a ring
3. 1 dc into each chain to end of round (you may want to use a stitch marker) 45 stitches
4. 1 dc into each stitch to end (remember to move your marker) 45 stitches
5. Repeat last round for 60 cm.
6. Last round continue to last stitch and 1 dc into stitch and slip stitch into next stitch. Change texture by changing various yarns throughout first 30 cm. (Last 30 cm should be simple DK or chunky as this will form the inside)
7. Joins side seams and push first half inside second half to form a double tube. Sew the two ends together to form a double skin muff.

Decoration and finishing

Now is the time if you want to decorate the muff body with beads, flowers, zips, loops etc.

We also need some muffs without buttons and beads these need to have some small cloths of different textures attached.

What you will need

Any left over and odd balls of yarn

Hook: Use whatever you would use to get a nice firm square (all Crocheter's know that everyone's tension is different.

Please ensure everything is sewn on firmly and securely.
