

HOW TO KNIT A TWIDDLE MUFF

- CUFF
- Cast on 40 stitches using 2 strands of double knitting wool, (or you can also use 1 strand of chunky wool).
- Work in stocking stitch (knit a line pearl a line) for 11 inches.
- MUFF BODY
- Continuing with stocking stitch and using up oddments of various textures of wool e.g: chunky, mohair, ribbon until work measures 23 inches. Then cast off.
- Neatly join side together with pearl side facing you. Turn inside out.
- Push the cuff up inside the muff body
- Neatly sew together the two ends as pictured above.
- Decoration and
- finishing
- Now is the time if you want to decorate the muff body with beads, flowers, zips, loops etc.
- We also need some muffs without buttons and beads these need to have some small cloths of different textures attached
- **Please ensure everything is sewn on firmly and securely.**

What you will need

Any left over and odd balls of yarn

Needles: 8mm circular
